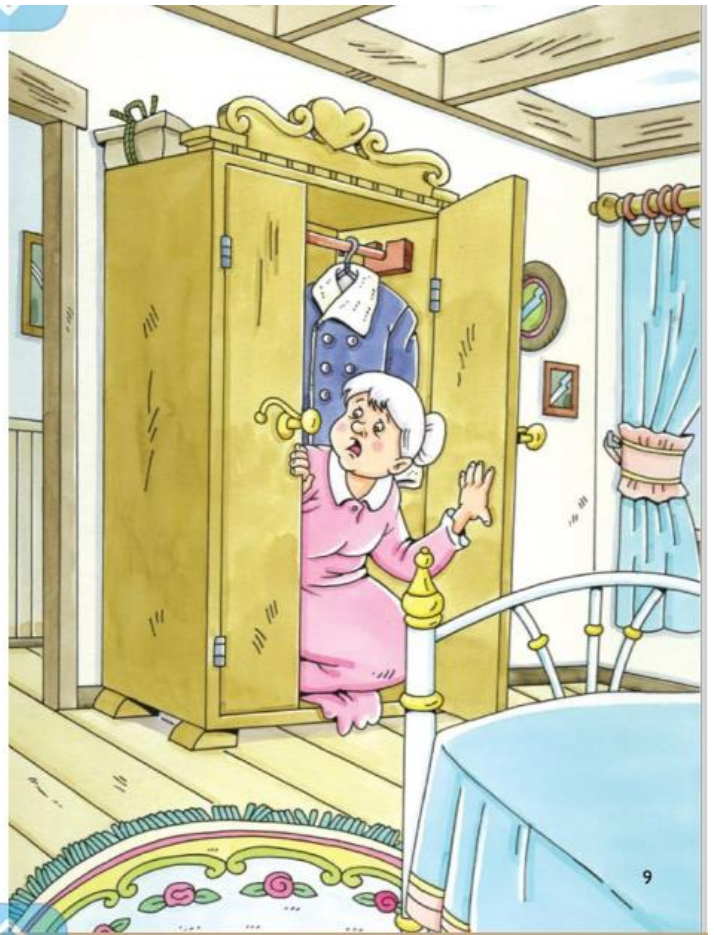

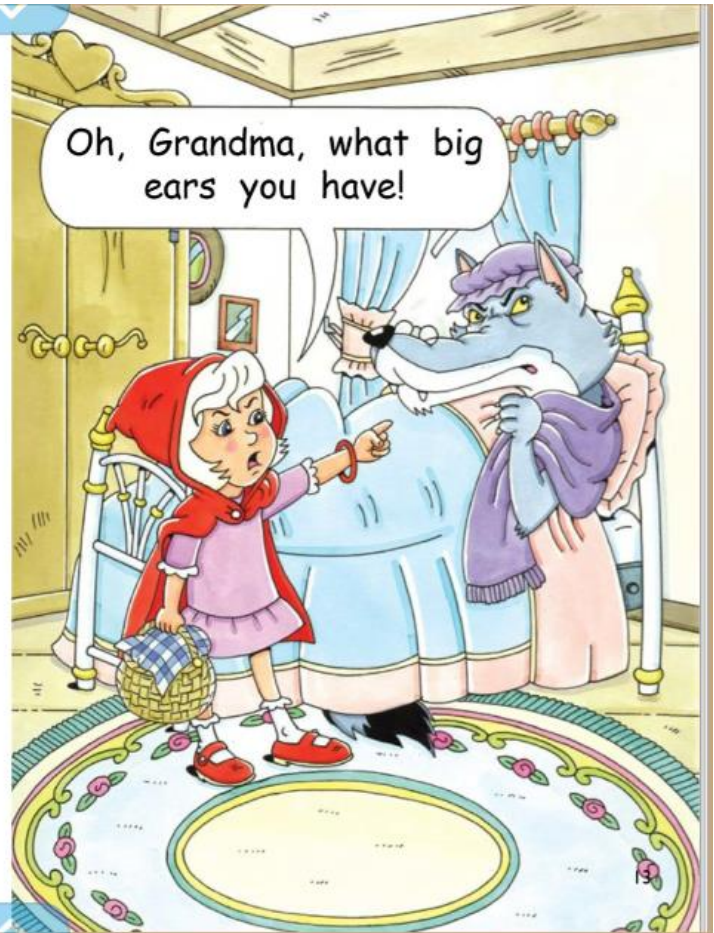

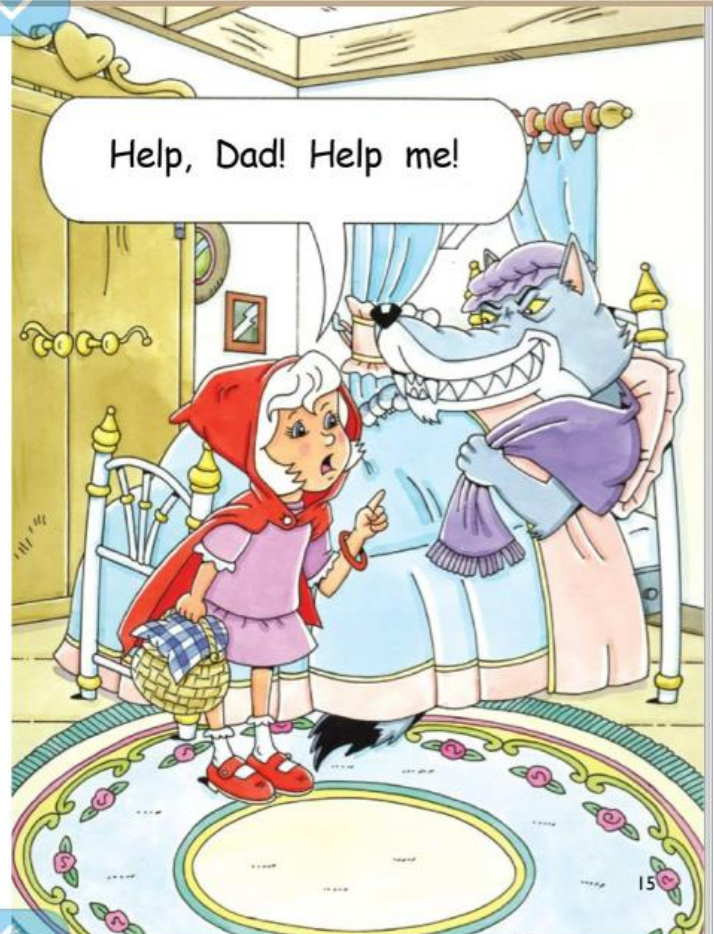


Oh, Grandma, what big ears you have!



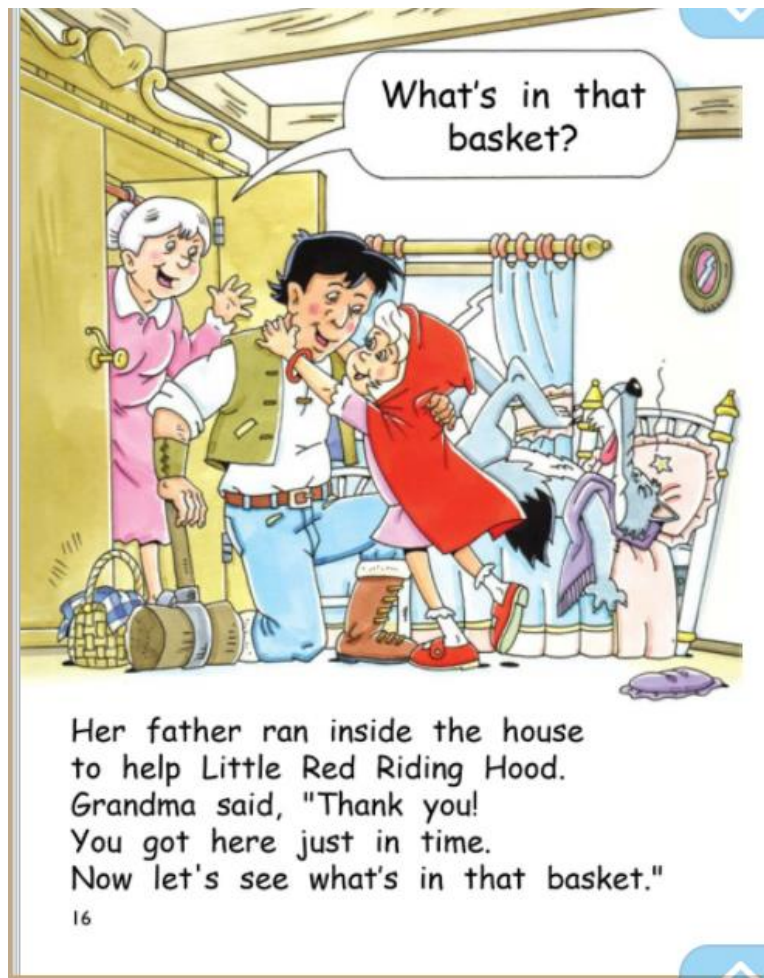
Little Red Riding Hood cried, "But Grandma, what big teeth you have!"
