On Earth, the aliens were no bigger than tiny bugs!

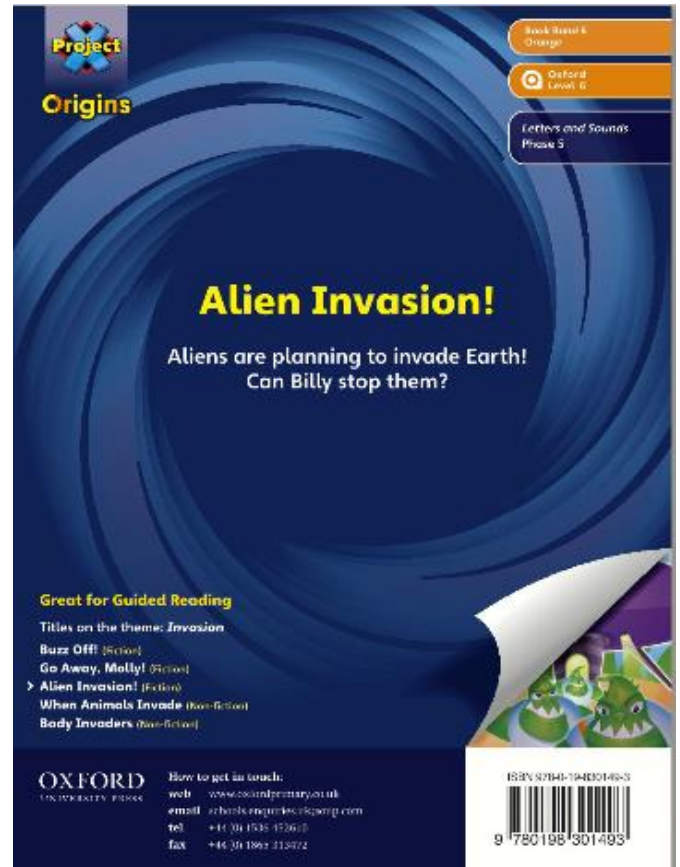
